The Government of the Pitcairn Islands is seeking to appoint a skilled and motivated teacher with proven administration skills to this multi-faceted position.

Pitcairn Island is located in the Eastern South Pacific, approximately 500kms from the Gambier Islands of French Polynesia. With a land mass of just 4.5km² the Island is home for approximately 50 permanent residents and 10 additional off islanders bringing the total population to around 60

The successful applicant will be in sole charge of Pitcairn's only school with a roll of 3 children aged between 7 and 11 years old.

The position is offered on a one year contract from February 2018. The role would include the accompaniment of a partner but the Government is unable to accept dependent children onto the Island.

The competitive package includes the use of a two bedroom home, use of quad bikes and travel to and from the Island. There is also access to the internet, video conferencing facilities and a NZ linked phone system.
