Other options are being explored around longboat service for
PI, with a tender option like that used by Aranui5 as one
possibility, along with others. Discussion was had on how this
would be funded.
The business name, Pitcairn Travel was discussed.
The question was raised on whether the Administrator contacts
the AG's office around possible use of the name Pitcairn for
business registration and changing the legislation to allow this.
